Numeracy & Maths

Contexts for Learning

Literacy & English

Reading - To begin the term, we will be reading Grey Friars Bobby as a whole class in line with our Scotland topic. After this, we will complete a nonfiction block, allowing the children to focus on the different features of such books. Read to write tasks will incorporate metalinguistics, fact finding and note taking. We will also continue to challenge our knowledge and understanding of what we have read thorough using our Blooms Buttons Question Fans.

Writing - In writing, we will be focusing on the text types of Response and Exposition. This will be explicitly taught through teacher modelled lessons and will incorporate the children's parts of speech, grammar and writing knowledge.

Listening & Talking - This term for listening and talking, we will be looking at Scots Language through our Scotland mini topic and will be exploring the poems and songs of Robert Burns. We have our Class Showcase in March and will be focusing on using our voices when speaking to an audience. We will also continue to explore letter sounds and patterns through phonics lessons.
