Reading

Scots language will be the focus in class, we will be translating and interpreting meaning within Scots poems. We will be attempting to memorise and say a Robert Burns' poem. The class will also focus on non-fiction texts, where we will discuss features of these texts and how to use them.

Writing

Primary 6 will be focusing on responsive texts where we will explore reviews, persuade our reader, and focus on using emotive language. Following this we will enhance our knowledge of discursive writing, focusing on a balanced argument, connecting these and giving evidence for our arguments.

Within grammar we will be enhancing our knowledge of persuasive/emotive words. The class will be exploring words which show importance of an issue, continue to enhance our knowledge of adverbs and adjectives and figurative language.

Listening & Talking - Our Scots poem performances will be part of our listening and talking focus, we have been honing our eye contact when speaking to a group. PEBL will continue to help our presentation skills, where children will be taught and encouraged to make flashcards to aid their presentation skills. With our assembly in February, the children will be learning lines, remembering cues and developing clear speaking voices.
