Term 2 Overview

Numeracy & Maths

- Time; to recognise, show and match analogue and digital times. To recognise digital times on mobile devices and convert between 12- and 24-hour times.
- Time; To calculate time durations using word problems and 12-hour time tables in durations of hours, half hours and 15 minute time intervals.
- Multiplication and division; To use skip counting to help solve multiplication and division problems. To identify the links between multiplication and division.
- Multiplication and division; to know my 2, 3-, 4-, 5- and 10-times tables. To multiply and divide by 10 and 100.
 Begin to multiply 2-digit numbers by a single digit using times table knowledge to help.
- Fractions, Decimals, and Percentages; To compare and order fractions depending on the size. To find a fraction of a quantity, using times tables knowledge to support this.
- Expression and equations; To understand and accurately use the terms 'equal to', 'not equal to', 'less than' and 'greater than'. To use a function machine involving simple operations.

Literacy & English

Reading - In term 2 Primary 4 will be continuing to develop their Active Literacy Reading strategies. We will continue to develop these skills using our class novel Eco Wolf and the Three Little Pigs. We will continue with our group reading books and will start to focus on independently completing tasks on the strategies of Inference, main ideas, and features of a text an author uses to build suspense or add intrigue. (punctuation, word choice and similes and metaphors). We will also continue to focus on Comprehension skills, using the question as part of our answer.

Writing - We are continuing to develop our descriptions and adding more detail to our writing. We are also going to be learning about the text types of response and exposition. We will also develop our editing skills making sure our writing makes sense and contains the correct punctuation.

Listening & Talking - We will continue to develop our skills that are needed for partner work and group work. Thinking about when it is time to listen and when it is time to speak, linking this to different roles for group work. We will also be developing our presenting skills further by sharing with the class our PEBL research.
