Uniform

- School uniform is promoted to ensure inclusion and belonging.
- Policy written with representatives of **ALL** stakeholders.
- Branded and badged items **NOT** required.
- Free uniform bank in school.
- Uniform costs should **NOT** exceed clothing grant.
- Blazers **NOT** compulsory.
- Captaincy Team receive **FREE** blazer throughout their tenure.

Trips & Travelling

- Consideration given to costs - no one will miss out on trip due to cost.
- Free bus passes available and promoted to all.
- We will walk or use public transport where practicable.
- Trips will be considered carefully before booking.
- Free packed lunches will be offered to anyone usually eligible for free school meals
- School uniform will be worn on trips and we will NOT visit shops.

Residential

- Families will receive at least one year's notice and trip will not cost more than £20 a month.
- Please inform headteacher discreetly if this is a barrier to your child attending.
- Old clothes preferred.

Eating

- Free breakfast club at 8.15am.
- Free school meals available for P1-5 and those in receipt of FSM /SCB n P6-7.
- Surplus fruit offered.

Clubs & Events

- All school clubs are free - no cost at all.
- Kits provided for netball, athletics and football events.
- Transport to and from events is **FREE** to learners.
- Consideration given to 'gaps' in achievement.
- Free events at School Fayres.
- Family tickets to events.
- Discos free - donations can be made but not required.
- Charity events - selected at start of year and limited.

Communication

- Timetable of events and associated costs or donations communicated timeously.
- All literature will ensure COSD is referenced and considered.
