School Consultation and Partnership

Whilst we don't charge or raise much from disco's, donations do help us to cover the costs of the DJ and snacks.

I hope we can continue to provide these events for our kids, they always seem to have a brilliant time!

Why We Need YOU!

To keep providing these amazing experiences for our children, we need our Parent Partnership to continue and so we're asking for your help.
