Term 2 Overview

Numeracy & Maths

- FRACTIONS/DECIMALS/ PERCENTAGES – mixed numbers, improper fractions, add/subtract fraction and decimals.
- EXPRESSION & EQUATIONS- solving algebraic equations with a variable
- ANGLES/ SYMMETRY/ TRANSFORMATION- classify a range of angles, measure and draw angles, calculate missing angles, interpret maps with compass points and simple scales. Identify line symmetry with 2D shapes. Plot and record points on x-y coordinate notation.
- MEASURE- convert measurements, perimeter, area, volume.
- PROBLEM SOLVING- Strategies for this term are 'try a simpler case' and 'act out the situation'.

Literacy & English

Reading

- Group books focus on 'inference', 'clarifying' and 'questioning' active reading strategies.
- Exploring scripts (stage directions, layout, character voices) in preparation for Leavers show.

Writing
